**Policy Statement:** MATC students may be allowed to complete court-mandated

community service hours on the MATC campus or on MATC-

controlled property.

**Rationale:** This policy will allow students to work towards completion of their program of studies while satisfying the dictates of the court.

## **Procedure:**

- 1. To be eligible to complete court-mandated community service hours under MATC supervision, the student must be in good standing according to MATC guidelines, and have been charged with no more than a misdemeanor offense.
- 2. Duties/projects assigned will be at the discretion/approval of the MATC president or his/her designee.
- 3. Such duties may be custodial in nature, but will consist of assigned tasks separate from the daily custodial duties performed by the MATC custodian(s).
- 4. Court generated documents designating number of assigned hours and completion timelines will be furnished by the student and signed as necessary by the MATC custodian/project supervisor.
- 5. Such documentation will be returned to the appropriate court services officer upon completion of the designated number of hours and accompanied by a cover letter from the MATC president or his/her designee.
- 6. A copy of the above-specified documentation will be made a part of the student's cumulative file.
